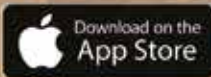

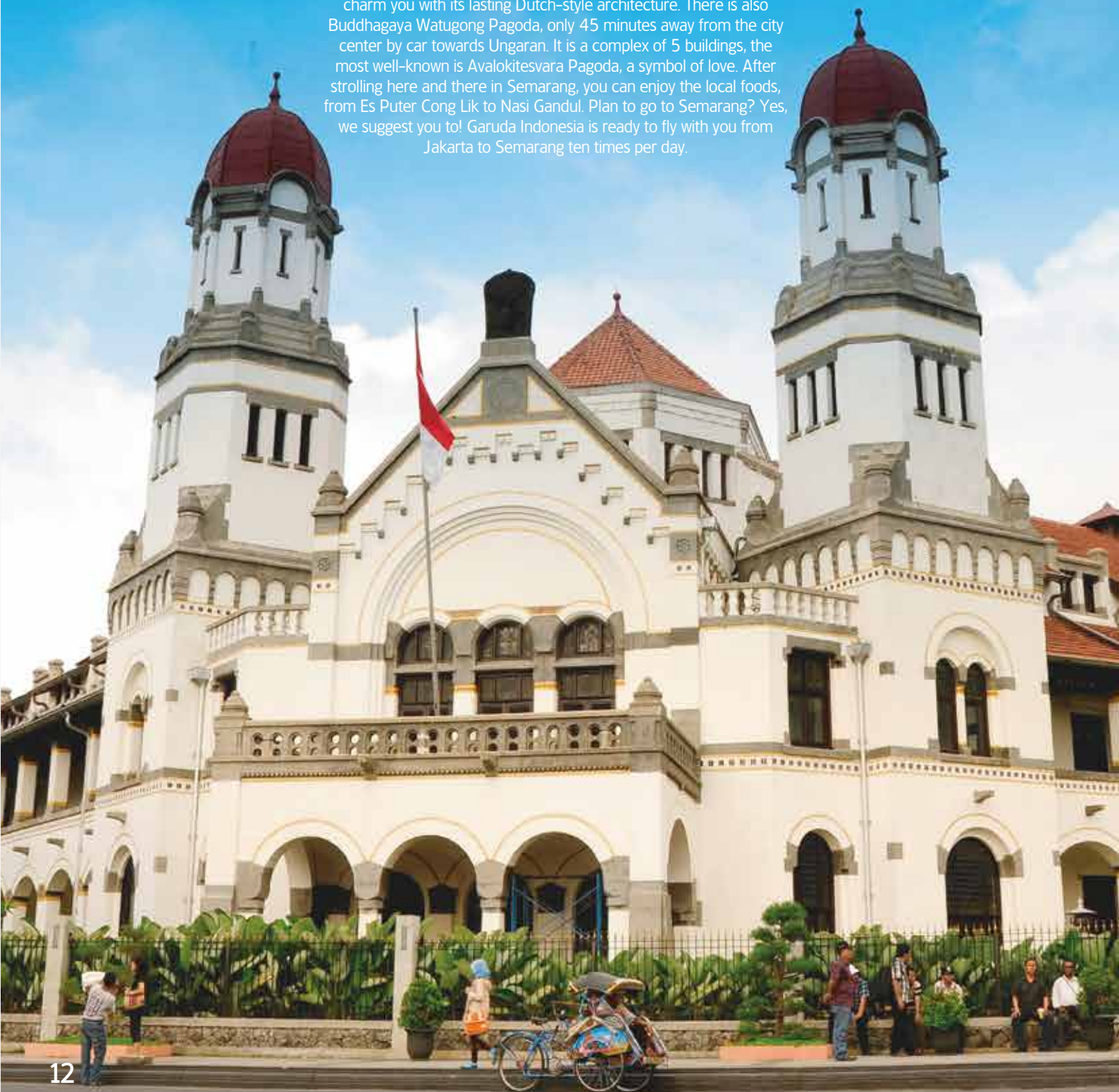
“City of Music”

What’s a visit to Kuala Lumpur without visiting KLCC. There is a long number of things to do here. Together with the iconic Petronas Twin Towers, this area is something of a city within a city. The simplest version of nasi lemak is just coconut rice, sambal paste (a spicy shrimp paste), fried anchovies, peanuts, and hardboiled egg. Fancier versions will have fried chicken (ayam goreng) or chicken rendang on the side.

The main display must be from the confectionery maker Glico's sign, featuring a runner with both arms raised. Right past the Dotonbori area is the Shinsaibashi shopping street lined with restaurants and apparel stores. This street is crowded with people every day so better prepare for a lot of walking.

The Forbidden City is home to some of the oldest buildings in China. You must schedule your morning to visit this place so you have enough time to explore the entire complex. Rent an audio guide at the entrance to fully immerse yourself in its rich history. Don't worry though because there are several languages available. This is definitely the best for you to visit in order to understand the culture of ancient China.

The Bund, also known as Zhongshan Dong Yi Lu (East Zhongshan 1st Road), has been regarded as the symbol of Shanghai for hundreds of years. The famous waterfront beach and the tall skyscraper buildings makes an excellent background for your photo. We advise you to not rush while walking in the Bund because the stroll is worth enjoying. By the way, if you get hungry on your stroll, you can always grab a snack in the few cafes around the corner.

You know what they say, you didn’t go to Shanghai if you didn’t shop at Cheng Huang Miao Market. This market is the land of crowds and cheap goods. Our souvenir recommendations:

- ◎ Chinese dolls dressed in traditional costumes
- ◎ Fake food keychains
- ◎ “Lucky” streamers in bright colors
- ◎ I heart Shanghai panda bag

Pro tip: if you buy souvenirs in bulk, it can be a lot cheaper. A bit of haggling doesn’t hurt either.

If your style is a little bit more elite, we suggest you visit Shanghai Nanjing Road instead. This is China’s Premier Shopping pedestrian street. The road is about 5.5-km-long and you can find not only upscale stores, but traditional and specialty stores as well. Come nightfall, the street comes alive with the flashing neon signs that illuminate the sky. Going on an evening stroll in Nanjing Road is the perfect way to enjoy this lively city.

Xiao Long Bao, the taste of Shanghai. Xiao Long Bao is basically soup dumplings or in some menus here, juicy steamed buns. These dumplings are made by folding a gelatin filling into a thin round of wheat dough. When the dumpling is steamed, the smell is just delicious. When you take your first bite, the gelatin-rich broth just melts out to your mouth. Or eat like a pro by nibbling off the corner of the dough and suck the soup out. But if you’re really hungry just eat the whole thing in one go.

Lie underneath the road that you will walk on there are large glass panels that you can look down into which reveals the historic road from the past.

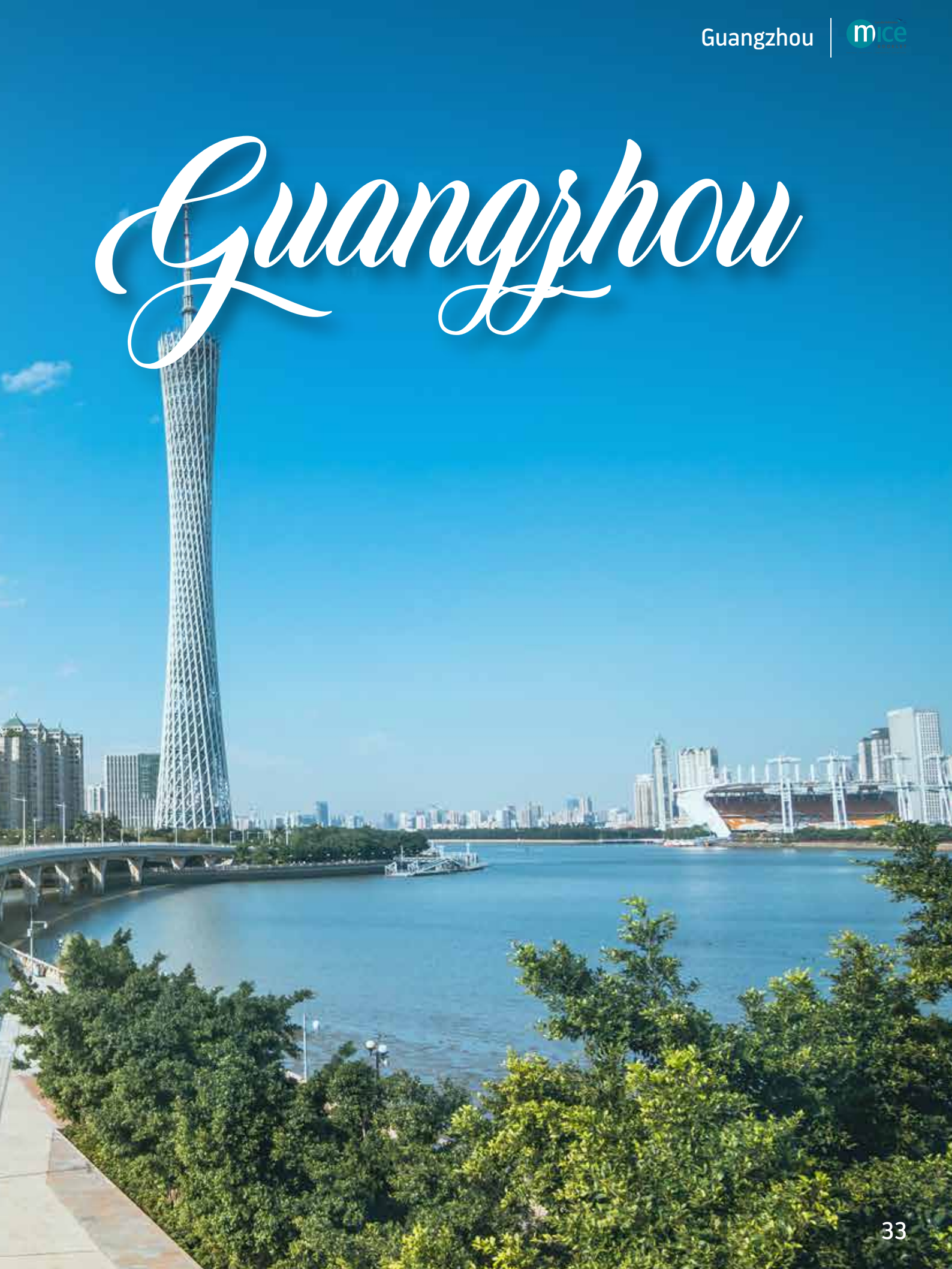
