

OPERATIONAL RESULT JANUARY 2017



SUMMARY

In the first month of 2017, Garuda Indonesia Group has maintained the passenger carried to rise approximately three times of Indonesia GDP growth, or increased by 13.56%YoY compared to the same period last year. In this period the demand growth is maintained higher compared to production growth, the capacity (ASK) was expanded by 12.55%YoY while the demand (RPK) rised by 16.71%YoY. These things already supported Garuda Indonesia Group to set the Seat Load Factor (SLF) on level 72.47%. Aligning with the growing phase of passenger, cargo carried also kept to boost by 15.53%YoY and impacted the Cargo Load Factor (CLF) achieve the level 49.28%

The risk of yield declines remains a challenge in 2017, but the risk is no greater than what was faced in 2016. Passenger yield declined by 4.88%YoY in this periode, however the drop is lower compared to the same periode last year was declined 13.78%YoY due to price war and lowest season of the year . Aircraft utilization also maintained to use 09:22 hours, or higher compared last year was 08:31 hours. In the cost section, unit cost (CASK) increased by 2.12%YoY due to fuel price rebounds at level USD 0.51/L, or boosted 30.77%YoY. The CASK Ex Fuel was controlled to fall by 7.18%YoY-due to several efficiency program of non fuel cost and fleet reduction along 2016.

Performance By Segment

The growing operational performance is mostly supported by international platform and LCC Citilink. For the international platform, passenger carried increased by 25.80%YoY. This passenger growth is above the production (ASK) growth was 17.21%YoY and the RPK growth was 22.73%YoY. Passenger yield was facing declining trend 5.66%YoY however it's lower compared last year.

Citilink maintained the passenger growth increased by 17.87%YoY, or above the ASK growth was 9.27%YoY. This condition support Citilink to set the SLF to be 77.91%. Citilink also has successfully to maintain the yield increased by 0.20%YoY, unfortunately the cost was increased significantly due to fuel price declining and additional fleets.

EXPAND CARGO SERVICES TO EAST INDONESIA

PT Pos Indonesia and PT Garuda Indonesia Tbk Persero to make a deal through the opening of cargo services prime outlet in Makassar, South Sulawesi. In addition to the implementation of SOEs synergy, Garuda Cargo opens the new cargo office in PT Pos Indonesia Makassar to expand the network distribution through the Cargo's door to door services such as the shipping of general cargo, valuable goods and dangerous goods in eastern Indonesia, including the fishery commodity as the potential resources in this region.
